- Certificate or diploma program (Tourism, Vet assistant, etc)
- Trades program (Welding, Carpentry, Electrician, Parts Technician, etc)
- Work

February 7

- Timetable will be semi-finalized
- If staffing changes, timetable may change anytime before September

Sometime in June

- Tentative student timetables for 2018-19 available to students and parents
- A copy will be sent home with the final report card at the end of June
