Required Courses:

Your child will be placed in all of the following required grade 8 courses:

- √ Careers Education 8 (MCE--08)
- √ Humanities 8 (MEN--08HUM)
- √ Mathematics 8 (MMA--08)
- √ Physical and Health Education 8 (MPHE-08)
- √ Science 8 (MSC--08)
- √ French 8 (MFR--08)
- √ Elective 8 Rotation A
- √ Elective 8 Rotation B

Elective Courses:

According to the British Columbia Language Education Policy, students must take French in grades 5, 6, 7, and 8. While French is not a requirement for graduation, a grade 11 or 12 second language is required by some post-secondary institutions. All grade 8 students will be placed in French 8. Parents who are interested in having their student exempted from French 8 (based on the BC Language Education Policy) should contact the school counselor.
